

Aurel Ionita – C.V. (summary)



He comes from a family of the well-known "lautari" village from Clejani, Giurgiu County, having musical roots on both sides, from mother and from father. Since the age of 14 he has been singing at weddings and various parties together with her family. After the 90's, he has accumulated new experiences and collaborations with established artists. In 1998 he founded his first Band-Rom Bengale. In 2000, musical arrangement at cd Iag Bari, together with the Ciocarlia fanfare. In 2002, a musical arrangement with Kočani Orkestar at cd - Alone at my wedding. In 2004 he sets up the band Mahala Rai Banda and participates in the great Womex Expo festival. Launch the first cd. Mahalageasca and the world hit with the same name "Mahalageasca". Artistic director Stephan Karo. In 2006, along with Stephan Karo, he performs the soundtrack of the first Romanian Tele novella opera "Haker" by Alexandra Gulea, directed by Thomas Ciulei. In 2008, along with the same Stephan Karo, he made the soundtrack of the movie Borat directed by Sacha Cohen, the soundtrack of the Animat Planet animation series from Antenna 1. In 2009 he performs the 2nd cd "Ghetto Blasters" artistic director Henry Ernst. In 2010 at the production house "Ovo Music" he signs, together with Ionel Tudor, the orchestral arrangements on the album "Lacrima de Jar" with the well-known singer Monica Anghel.

The song "Mahalageasca" was included on the soundtrack of "Borat" as well as in other cinematographic productions and various advertising spots: Voronskaya, Conex, C.E.C, Eurocard Mastercard, Altex / BlakFriday etc.
