How to reach Montegranaro

For national and international participants, there are several ways to reach Montegranaro:

- **by plane:** the nearest airport is [Ancona](#) (about 55 km distance) which is connected only to Munich, London, Tirana, Palermo and Charleroi , followed by [Pescara](#) (about 120 km from Montegranaro) which is mainly Ryanair connected with Milano Bergamo - Barcelona - Charleroi - Bucarest - Catania - Dusseldorf - Frankfurt- Krakow - London - Malta - Torino - Warsaw

Roma-Fiumicino is a bit far away, but with the advantage to be connected with whole Europe and to have a fast and cheap **direct** [bus connection](#) with Montegranaro

- **by bus:** even if there are good local bus services, best of all is to use [train](#) to “Fermo - Porto San Giorgio” station on the mainline Bologna- Bari
- **by car:** the fastest route is the Motorway Bologna-Bari A14 (way out Civitanova Marche) and then follow the indications on national route SS77, then SS78
- **by train:** Montegranaro station (Fermo-Porto San Giorgio, then local direct buses) is on the main line Bologna-Bari, therefore with many Intercity and Local trains. Check connections [here](#)
