How to reach Sibiu

For national and international participants, there are several ways to reach Sibiu:

- **by plane:** the nearest airport is [Sibiu International Airport](#) (15 minutes driving distance airport - city centre). Sibiu Airport is connected to: Dortmund - Munchen - London - Wien - Stuttgart - Menningem - Madrid - Nurberg - Copenhagen - Bruxelles - Paris - Basel - Frankfurt - Bucarest. Sibiu Airport is mainly served by [Wizz Air](#) and [Lufthansa](#).

Bucharest [Henri Coandă International Airport](#) (5 hours by car) is recommended for overseas international participants.

Also [Cluj-Napoca](#) airport is available and not so far, but there are no direct bus connections to Sibiu, check bus website hereunder for further info.

- **by bus:** there are several bus companies with routes to Sibiu; availability can be checked on the this [website](#), which is available in many languages.
- **by car:** the fastest route from Bucharest to Sibiu is via **A1/E81** (București-Pitești- Râmnicu Vâlcea-Sibiu). The fastest route from Budapest to Sibiu is on **E75-E68** (Budapest-Szeged-Nădlac-Arad-Deva-Alba Iulia-Sibiu).
- **by train:** the schedule for international trains to and from Romania is on the following websites available in English: www.bahn.de or www.InterRail.eu
